The Mining History Journal welcomes manuscripts on any subject in mining and metallurgical history in any area or region. Manuscripts, books for review, inquiries regarding advertising or the purchase of back issues of the journal, and other correspondence related to the journal should be sent to: Mining History Journal, Department of History, MS2960, Southeast Missouri State University, Cape Girardeau, MO 63701, or eclements@semo.edu.

Manuscripts should be submitted typed, double-spaced, and with endnotes. The journal only accepts manuscripts via e-mail or CD, in Microsoft WORD or WordPerfect format. A clean paper copy of the manuscript is requested along with the CD. All articles are required to follow the style formats specified in the *Chicago Manual of Style*, 15th edition.

Illustrations should not be embedded in the article, but their locations should be indicated in the text and captions provided. Submit photos as paper copies or as separate files scanned as TIFF or JPEG at a minimum of 5 by 7 inches and 300 dpi. Authors are responsible for obtaining copyright use permissions for all illustrations and for paying any associated fees.
